



Tithe Funds Available for Gamlingay Organisations

Applications are invited for funds from the Gamlingay Community Turbine Tithe Fund – deadline 31 March or 30 September

Applications for funds should be submitted in writing on an application form available from one of the following: -

- By post or hand to: GCT, Maypole House, 39 Church Street, Gamlingay

Application forms are available in the Eco-Hub, for download from the website (g-c-t.uk) or on request by emailing mail.gct@gmx.com.

All applications should be submitted by **31 March or 30 September**. No more than 2 applications may be submitted by any individual or organisation within one year.

The decision on the first funding awards will be made by a Tithe Panel meeting in April and November each year. Note that the decision may not be made at the initial meeting and may be announced later.

The Tithe Panel will comprise:

1. A person nominated by GCT
2. A person representing Gamlingay Parish Council – If GPC do not appoint somebody then GCT may appoint another person.
3. A person representing Forward Gamlingay! - If FG! does not appoint somebody then GCT may appoint another person.

The guidelines for the Tithe Panel are:

1. The donation should benefit Parishioners of Gamlingay.
2. The donation should benefit more than just a single person or family.
3. GCT will prefer applications that will result in helping our environment but anything will be considered.
4. If a member of the Panel has any pecuniary interest in any application under consideration at that meeting they must declare it and stand down from that meeting.
5. The Panel's decision is final and not open to appeal.

The beneficiary organisation should have a bank account suitable for receiving funds by transfer.

The beneficiaries must ensure that the funds are spent according to the approved application. Please mention the Tithe Fund in any reports about the project that benefits, for instance an article in the Gamlingay Gazette.
